- Divisions:** Divisions available at check-in with the approximate timing of events.
All divisions are adjustable to size, number of entries, age, etc. to ensure fairness.
- Format:** Pattern competition
Minimum, two 90-second round sparring matches for all competitors
- Equipment:** Sparring gear is required for all students ages 10+ and all green belts and higher ranks.
- It is recommended for white and yellow belt competitors ages nine and under.
 - Sparring gear includes hand, foot, and head gear (soft dipped foam, cloth, leather, or synthetic fabric), and a mouth guard.
 - Groin protection is required for male competitors.
 - Shin pads and chest protectors are optional.
- Awards:** Quality custom medals for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place in each event
- T-Shirts:** Tournament t-shirts available for purchase (more information to come)
- Concession:** Cash-only concession will be available with snacks, drinks, and hot food items
